Charles Edgar Cole

Birth/Established: November 30, 1850 **Death/Dissolved:** October 10, 1910

Biography:

Charles Cole was active as a Cleveland architect from 1885 to 1909. In 1893 he formed a partnership with Ora Williams that lasted one year. He spent four years as a contractor. In 1901 he returned to the architectural profession, opening an office in the Colonial Arcade. He retired in 1909.
