W Stillman Dutton

Birth/Established: August 28, 1866 **Death/Dissolved:** April 6, 1914

Biography: W. Stillman Dutton was active as a Cleveland architect from 1893 until 1912. In 1893 he was a member of the firm of Watterson and Dutton. He lived at 1064 East 97th Street. His office was first in the Society for Savings and then the New England Building.
